The Outpatient Prescription Drug Formulary is the cornerstone for a progressive program of managed care pharmacotherapy. Its goal is to ensure that members receive therapeutically appropriate and cost effective drug therapy.

The Formulary will promote rational, scientific care based on consideration of published clinical studies, FDA data, community standards, and cost-benefit evaluations. As described in our provider agreements, the Formulary should serve as a primary reference in the selection of medications for our members.

To keep pace with the continuous advances in pharmacotherapeutics, the Formulary requires on-going revision. The Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee will regularly review the Formulary to ensure that it continues to meet the needs of members and providers.

Effective use of the Outpatient Prescription Drug Formulary is based on the support of our provider physicians and pharmacists. Your cooperation in the safe and effective prescribing of pharmaceuticals is greatly appreciated.

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## I. Pharmacy Programs and Policy

## II. The Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee

The purpose of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee is to maintain the Outpatient Prescription Drug Formulary and to serve as an advisory body on matters related to the therapeutic use of drugs.

The P&T Committee is composed of practicing physicians and pharmacists representing a wide variety of specialties. The Committee meets regularly, throughout the year, and the recommendations of the Committee are communicated to our participating physicians and pharmacists.

The P&T Committee maintains and revises the Formulary as necessary. Formulary revision is based on objective evaluation of the efficacy, safety, and the cost of reviewed medications. In addition, the Committee recommends and reviews programs and procedures that promote cost-effective use of drugs, such as drug utilization review programs, as well as educational programs presented to participating physicians and health care professionals on matters related to drug therapy.

## V. Explanation of Cost Index

## VI. Non-Formulary Medication Access

We encourage our physician providers to prescribe Blue Cross of California Formulary agents whenever medically appropriate.

Some pharmacy benefits exclude or limit coverage of certain formulary and/or non-formulary medications. Only a treating physician can determine what medications are appropriate for a patient. Please refer to the applicable plan for the detailed information regarding plan benefits, conditions, limitations and exclusions.

## VII. Use of Generics

We endorse the use of FDA approved bioequivalent generics and encourage the prescribing and dispensing of these generic medications whenever medically appropriate.

The P&T Committee recognizes that certain medications possess narrow therapeutic dose response characteristics. Therefore, the Committee discourages the use of generic substitutes for drugs classified by the FDA as having a narrow therapeutic index (NTI).

## VIII. Preferred Drug Program

Many Blue Cross members are enrolled in the Preferred Drug Program (PDP). Under the PDP, a select list of non-preferred medications are not covered or are available at a higher copay based on benefit design. Non-preferred medications are available through our network of community pharmacies when the prescriber denotes medical necessity by indicating "Do Not Substitute" (DNS) or "Dispense as Written" (DAW) on a written or verbal prescription.

We reserve the right to add newly FDA approved drugs to the Preferred Drug Program as appropriate.

If the prescriber prefers not to use the DNS/DAW override, a written request for a non-preferred drug may be faxed to WellPoint NextRx at 1-888-831-2243.

## IX. Prescription Quantity Limits and Early Refill

Blue Cross of California has identified a number of select medications which will be subject to quantity limits. Simply stated, a quantity limit establishes the maximum amount of a prescription medication Blue Cross of California will cover as a benefit within a defined period of time. Quantity limits are implemented in one of three ways: on a per day basis (e.g., 1 tablet per day), per prescription or per 30 days.

These prudent maximums and early refills requirements allow for a medically appropriate upper limit for the vast majority of our members. If you feel that your patient has a medical condition requiring a quantity of medication or an early refill that exceeds our limits, a written prior authorization may be submitted to request a larger quantity per prescription.

We reserve the right to assign a quantity limit to other agents as appropriate.

## X. Prior Authorization of Benefits

Select formulary drugs require prior authorization of benefits. Medication utilization must meet FDA-approved indications as well as the Blue Cross of California guidelines. Other medications are subject to prior authorization of benefits according to the P&T Committee recommendations. ## XI. Self-Injectables

## XII. Medi-Cal and Healthy Families Program

The Medi-Cal and Healthy Families pharmacy benefit follows the Blue Cross of California Formulary. However, due to state regulations which are enforced, there are specific restrictions:

**Mandatory Generic** – The generic equivalent of a prescribed medication will be dispensed to members when a generic alternative is available. Brand medications with a generic alternative will require prior authorization of benefits.

**Day Supply** – The pharmacy benefit is limited to a 30 day supply for both Medi-Cal and Healthy Families with the following exceptions:

- (1) The Medi-Cal benefit was expanded to allow a 90 day supply for select groups of medication including oral contraceptives, prenatal vitamins, asthma drugs, diabetes medication, cardiovascular drugs and anti-tuberculosis drugs
- (2) Healthy Families members can receive a 90 day supply of maintenance medications through our mail order pharmacy, PrecisionRX and a 30 day supply through a participating retail pharmacy

**Non-Formulary Medications** – Non-Formulary medication coverage is as follows:

- (1) All non-formulary prescription medications will require prior authorization of benefits for all Medi-Cal members only. Consequently, the DNS/DAW override does not apply
- (2) For our Healthy Families members, most non-formulary medication are available with the DNS/DAW override after a treatment failure, contraindication to a Formulary agent(s), or at the discretion of the prescribing physician

**Carve Outs** – Select drugs and drug classes are carved out of the pharmacy benefit and are reimbursed by fee for service (FFS) Medi-Cal or California Children's Services (CCS). CCS carve outs are applicable to only Medi-Cal. The Department of Health Services carve outs for HIV and anti-psychotic medications apply specifically to Medi-Cal and are reimbursable through Electronic Data Systems (EDS).

**Over the Counter (OTC) Medications** – Blue Cross of California Medi-Cal members can receive select OTC medications through the pharmacy benefit when the physician prescribes the agent via a prescription. The Healthy Families program does NOT provide coverage of OTC drugs, however, they are available at the expense of the member.
